Art - Monochromatic: How do artists draw from perspective?

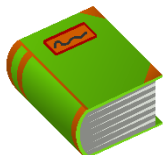
Music - Mamma Mia

1. Read to an adult at home at least 4 times a week. Discuss what happened/what the text was about after reading. Ask the adult to record the date, which pages you have read and sign your reading record each time you read to them. When you have finished a book, it is your responsibility to change it. Remember to bring in your reading wallet every day.

2. Complete 5 games on Times Table Rockstars on Mon, Tues, Wed and Thurs evenings (or the following mornings before school). Your password is in the front of your reading record. If you are struggling, write out the times table, and use this to help you answer the questions. Remember to click refresh each day before playing or it won't register your games.



3. Complete the weekly maths homework and grammar homework tasks on Sumdog by Friday each week. Your password is in the front of your reading record. Each week's homework is live from the previous Friday.

You will earn a reward token in Friday's Celebration Assembly each week that you complete all of your homework 😊
